Goals for Student Learning

District Goals:

- To improve the percentage of students scoring proficient (levels 3, 4) in grades 3 through 8.
- To improve the percentage of students graduating from high school

SMART Goals:

- By April 2020, 45% of our students will score at the Proficient or Distinguished Learner levels on Georgia Milestones - ELA.
- By April 2020, 42% of our students will score at the Proficient or Distinguished Learner levels on Georgia Milestones - Math.
- By April 2020, 33% of our students will score at the Proficient or Distinguished Learner levels on Georgia Milestones - Social Studies.
- By April 2020, 44% of our students will score at the Proficient or Distinguished Learner levels on Georgia Milestones - Science.

Areas of Emphasis:

- In ELA our grade level will focus on reading fluency and comprehension, as well as informational, narrative, persuasive, and opinion writing.
- In Math our grade level will focus on math fact fluency, multistep word problems, and all areas of fractions.

Fifth Grade Student Goals:

- WSE students joined staff and parents to develop ideas about how they can succeed and reach for the stars in math and language arts. Students thought of the following ideas to make connections between learning at home and school:
- Read at grade level or higher for 20 minutes per day to get a 3 on GA Milestones
 - Study math and reading on iRead and Lexia every day.
 - Level up on Lexia.

Fifth Grade Teacher Goals:

- WSE teachers will work with students and their families to support students' success in language arts and math. Some of our key connections with families will be:
- Provide bi-weekly newsletters to parents containing vocabulary words and activities to practice understanding words. Reading logs to encourage independent reading. Daily writing in class to support growth in the writing process.
 - Multiplication and division fact practice 3-4 nights per week. Written step by step instruction on math standards, so parents can help students at home.
 - Send home math and ELA benchmark reports and provide resources to assist in learning fact fluency.

Fifth Grade Parent Goals:

- WSE parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' success in language arts and math.
- Set aside a quiet place for my child to do homework and make sure my child completes their homework
 - Read together and discuss books at home daily.
 - Stay in touch with my child's teacher through conferences, emails, notes and phone calls, etc., regarding ELA and math.
