Goals for Student Learning

District Goals:

- To improve the percentage of students scoring proficient (levels 3, 4) in grades 3 through 8.
- To improve the percentage of students graduating from high school

S.M.A.R.T. Goals:

- By May 2022, 50% of 2nd-grade students will score at or above Benchmark on the STAR Reading benchmark.
- By May 2022, 45% of 2nd-grade students will score at or above Benchmark on the STAR Math benchmark.

Areas of Emphasis:

- In ELA our grade level will focus on reading fluency and basic comprehension.
- In Math our grade level will focus on subtraction and addition facts.

Second Grade Student Goals:

WSE students joined staff and parents to develop ideas about how they can succeed and reach for the stars in math and language arts. Students thought of the following ideas to make connections between learning at home and school:

- Practice my addition and subtraction math facts every night with my family.
- Read for 20 minutes every night with my family.
- Tell my parents what I learned each day after school.

Second Grade Teacher Goals:

WSE teachers will work with students and their families to support students' success in language arts and math. Some of our key connections with families will be:

- Weekly dojo updates, weekly newsletters informing parents of specific standards/skills being taught, list of words with the phonics focus, weekly HFW words, and weekly fluency passages.
- Assigning daily lessons with Zearn as homework and providing family friendly math videos to assist in student and parent understanding.

Second Grade Parent Goals:

WSE parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' success in language arts and math.

- I will read the class newsletter so that I am informed of what will be taught and will give me the ability to help my child learn at home.
- I will read at home with my child and practice reading skills such as learning site words, vocabulary words, fluency, and reasoning.
- I will practice math facts with my child.
