# Goals for Student Learning

#### District Goals:

• To improve the percentage of students scoring proficient (levels 3, 4) in grades 3 through 8.

• To improve the percentage of students graduating from high school

#### S.M.A.R.T Goals:

- By April 2022, 54% of our students will achieve at the Proficient or Distinguished Learner levels on Georgia ELA Milestones.
- By April 2022, 55% of our students will achieve at the Proficient or Distinguished Learner levels on Georgia Math Milestones.

#### Areas of Emphasis:

• In ELA our grade level will focus on vocabulary development and reading comprehension.

• In Math our grade level will focus on multiplication and division facts.

#### Third Grade Student Goals:

- Read for 20 minutes every night with my family.
- Study spelling words and vocabulary words every night with my family.
- Practice my addition, subtraction, multiplication and division math facts every night.

#### Third Grade Teacher Goals:

WSE teachers will work with students and their families to support students' success in language arts and math. Some of our key connections with families will be:

• As a grade level, we will encourage parents to work with their children daily in recalling multiplication facts 1-10.

• As a grade level, we will have students regularly check out books from the library to take home that are on their reading level. We will also send home tips in newsletters and on DOJO for increasing reading stamina.

#### Third Grade Parent Goals:

WSE parents joined staff to develop ideas about how families can support students' success in language arts and math.

• I will read the class newsletter so that I am informed of what will be taught and will give me the ability to help my child learn at home.

• I will read at home with my child and practice reading skills such as learning site words, vocabulary words, fluency, and reasoning.

• I will practice math facts with my child.
